Age Restrictions

This tournament is open to participants from ages 4 to 12.

Registration

- To compete in the Frutee Mini Marvels Cosplay Tournament your child/ward must be an attendee of AnimeKon and in possession of a valid ticket if they are 5 and up.
- There are only 35 spots allocated for this year's competition.
- To secure your child/ward's spot please fill out the online entry form.
- Sign-up on the day of the show will only be permitted in the event that spots become available.
- Costumes may be bought or made.
- Weapons or sharp edged items that can be harmful to others need to have a covering/holster/sheath. Better yet, bring a plastic sword, not a real one, if you can.

Stage Use

- Costumes can be based on characters featured in Anime/Manga, Video games, Comic books, Graphic novels, Science Fiction or Fantasy. This list is not exhaustive.
- Each contestant/act will be allowed a maximum of 2 minutes on stage. The time can also be used to perform a skit.

Entrant Arrival

- All contestants must sign in at the AnimeKon Booth by **3:00 pm** on **Saturday, August 27th 2016**. You may sign in on behalf of your child/ward.
- Once contestants have signed in, there will be a briefing before taking to the stage for final judging.

Judging and Awards

- Each contestant will be assessed by three judges using the criteria previously stated – basically just having fun!
- The winners will be announced and awarded at the close of the competition.
